

CFP-RD2026 Call for Proposals - Rare Diseases

Conditions pre-application for Rare Disease Research

Background

Stichting Dioraphte is a Dutch private foundation that provides financial support to institutions serving the public interest, both domestically and internationally. More information can be found on our <u>website</u>.

Through its Science and Research portfolio, Dioraphte supports medical scientific research activities in the fields of rare diseases and neglected tropical diseases.

Rare diseases affect a significant portion of the population. However, as each individual disease is rare, there is a lack of funding for research and appropriate treatment. Therefore, Dioraphte allocates ≤ 1.7 million biennially to contribute to rare disease research. This is the *fourth call for proposals* focused on rare diseases.

A pre-application of up to **maximum five pages** may be submitted under the following conditions. This page limit excludes required references and biosketches. Only applications using the Dioraphte-provided application form will be considered.

Conditions

- The selection of pre-applications will follow the NWO-XS peer review system (see the pre-application form for details). Each applicant commits to this review system and its deadlines.
- The principal investigator of a winning proposal in the rare disease round 2026 must personally participate in the advisory/selection committee for the rare disease round 2028.
- The research must focus on diseases classified as rare (prevalence <1:2000). Applications specifically targeting (neuro)muscular disorders and metabolic disorders are <u>excluded</u> from this 2026 round.
- Applicants must be affiliated with a center of expertise that has been officially recognized by the Ministry. Note: Each recognized center (per AIMS ID <u>click here-</u>, and not per disease) may submit only one application.
- A maximum amount of €425,000 can be requested per application. Overhead costs may not exceed 15% of the total budget.
- There are no restrictions on the types of expenses (equipment, personnel, etc.), provided it is clearly justified how these will benefit the research.
- Applications from (co) applicants with ongoing Dioraphte funding are excluded from this round.
- Applications will be assessed based on the quality and societal impact of the proposal, as well as the quality of the center and research group (publications).
- Applications must be written in English and will only be considered if the Dioraphte application form is used.

Jioraphte

- In addition to the application, biosketches (maximum of five pages per person) of the principal investigators must be submitted. The NIH-style biosketch format can be used (NIH style; <u>click here</u> for an example). The 'eRA Commons user name' is not required). Alternatively, this year, you may also make use of the evidence-based CV from NWO (<u>click here</u>) or the ERDERA narrative CV (<u>click here</u>; see page 11/12). Regardless what template is chosen, a URL linking to all publications of the researcher (e.g., a direct PubMed link or ResearchGate page/ORCID) must be included.
- Applications must be submitted as a **single PDF file** (including application, references, and biosketch(es)) named as follows: [Last name applicant]_[Name UMC], e.g., Jansen_ErasmusMC.PDF.
- This file must be sent via email to: postbus@dioraphte.nl with the subject line: CfP-RD2026 and the applicant's last name.
- The deadline for pre-applications is **1**st of May 2025.
- Applications that do not meet the conditions will be excluded from participation without further notification.
- No correspondence will be conducted regarding the outcome.
